

# Benefits of Accepting Rental Assistance Housing Vouchers

- On time, monthly rental payments (direct deposit option)
- Assistance finding qualified tenants
- Assistance completing the program paperwork
- Potential for long-term responsible residents
- Up to \$5,000 for move-out damages above the security deposit and insurance coverage
- Access to a dedicated landlord specialist for support throughout the lease term
- An opportunity to give back to the community by providing rental units for those most in need

### Additional Assistance

- Assistance with applications, required forms, lease renewal documents
- Expand outreach to lease units quickly by sharing vacancies with community partners
- Resolve payment questions or concerns
- Enforce lease compliance issues
- Connect landlords to a voucher specialist or case manager
- Conduct optional visual inspections during the lease term
